1.	Dates and Location
	<p>„Survival in temporary isolation“: 08-14 July 2018: „Reconnaissance“: 15-21 July 2018. Participants are cadets/students/young military officers and they will carry out their activities in the Academy’s training camps from Perii Daii and Crintu, locations very close to the Academy. Participants to the „Survival in temporary isolation“ module are expected to come in Sibiu on the 8th of July and depart on the 14th of July 2018. Participants to the „Reconnaissance“ module are expected to come in Sibiu on the 15th of July and depart on the 21st of July 2018 Up to 50 participants will be admitted.</p>
2.	Accommodation and food
	The participants will be offered accommodation and meals free of charge in the Academy’s buildings.
3.	Costs
	No costs are required for accommodation and meals. No participation fee is required.
4.	Transportation
	Participants are requested to make their own travel arrangements to and from Sibiu (airport/railway station/bus station etc.). „Nicolae Balcescu“ Land Forces Academy will provide free transport from the above mentioned locations to the Academy and back. Transportation from/to local airport or railway stations must be required in advance, preferably one week before arrival to the event. Free transport will be provided for participants according to program throughout the entire duration of their stay.
