We were just about to board a much smaller plane this time, for our first African safari.

Our second flight, the one from Nairobi, lasted less than an hour, but was the most fascinating one I had ever been on. It took us out of the city until we reached Mount Kenya. It is much larger than many of Kenya's parks and a safe place for more than 250 species of birds and 50 species of mammals, including elephants. The wildlife here, unlike in the game parks, is still wild, and so, far more exciting to see than bored lions lying in front of tourists.
