

USEFUL INFORMATION FOR INCOMING INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

1. REGISTRATION:

If you have been selected to come to LFA, you must **send to the Programmes and International Relations Office (Erasmus+)** of the “Nicolae Balcescu” Land Forces Academy the following documents:

Before mobility:

- **Erasmus+ Student Application Form**, signed by your Erasmus+ Coordinator;
- **Accommodation Form** if you wish to have free accommodation in our academy;
- **Learning Agreement for Studies (Before, During and After the mobility);**
- **Training Agreement for Traineeship (Before, During and After the mobility);**
- **Photo – Every Erasmus+ student will receive a Student ID card and an access permit. The photo is required also for study documents;**
- Photocopy of an ID document (passport);
- Valid health insurance.

After mobility:

- Confirmation of Study/Traineeship Period;
- Transcript of Records.

Deadline for sending the documents:

- **End of July for the Autumn Semester;**
- **End of November for the Spring Semester.**

2. CREDIT SYSTEM:

The standard unit of study is the semester. The normal load of a semester is conventionally 30 credits. The convention of 30 credits/semester was chosen to adjust to the European Credit Transfer System (ECTS). The credits assess the normal volume of a student's work.

In Romania, marks are given on a scale of **1 to 10**, with **5** meaning that “*performance meets the minimum criteria required in order to pass*”, **10** meaning “*outstanding performance*”, and **1 to 4** meaning “*failed*”.

3. GRADING SCALE:

ECTS Grade	Romanian Grade	Definition
A	10	EXCELLENT - outstanding performance with only minor errors
B	9	VERY GOOD - above the average standard but with some errors
C	7-8	GOOD - generally sound work with a number of notable errors
D	6	SATISFACTORY - fair but with significant shortcomings
E	5	SUFFICIENT - performance meets the minimum criteria
FX/F	1-4	FAIL - considerable further work is required
