Communication skills

Due to the professional context, I managed various teams and situations that required adaptation within the implemented projects. At the same time, the relationship in university courses has suggested formulas for accommodation to particular cases of communication with students. From a professional point of view, students' anonymous evaluations of me represent a crucial indicator for the quality of communication.

The experience gained in international mobility, events, and study programs has visibly outlined my capacity for intercultural communication, both protocol and interpersonal. I can give public lectures and structure speeches; we have provided training and communication modules, communication, and public relations consultancy services to private beneficiaries, public institutions, and non-governmental organizations. In the academic space, I problematize and exemplify, and I use case studies that favour the development of students' negotiation and mediation skills. Every year, I organize a UN Security Council decision-making simulation with students to practice and develop their skills of exposure, effective communication, message structuring, negotiation, decision-making simulation, and conscious self-assessment. I value active feedback, and my concern is to engage in a more efficient communication process with the working partners.

Organisational / managerial skills

I have project management skills, coordinated project teams, managed financial and logistical resources, and remodelled processes and work schedules. As an NGO representative, I've been involved in volunteer activities since being a student have designed and developed a series of projects aimed at improving leadership and entrepreneurial skills. Analytical ability helped me to interpret and tackle specific management

situations. I have developed over 30 educational, institutional, and business partnerships. In my capacity as director of the Security Studies degree program, I demonstrated architectural and conceptualization ability; also coordinated the elaboration of the Security Studies file - thus being the first undergraduate program in this field proposed for authorization in Romania. I have managed projects financed following competitions, with many human resources and beneficiaries, which cumulatively exceed a value of 1 million euros.

Job related skills

Since the inception of the academic think tank, the Global Studies Center (GSC), in 2015, we have developed projects with foreign partners such as the University of Southeast Norway, the Heritage Foundation, Jamestown Foundation, German Council on Foreign Relations (DGAP). Efforts at the GSC level have focused on constructing policy papers and analysis briefs. In 2016, together with my Norwegian colleagues, we built a policy paper dedicated to the phenomenon of migration in Europe, a document disseminated to the specialized committees of the European Parliament. In 2018, with the support of the Foreign Affairs Department of the Romanian Presidency, under the High Patronage of the President of Romania, in partnership with the Romanian Embassy in the USA and with NATO support, we developed a project in Sibiu dedicated to the Wider Black Sea Region. It was the basis of a policy paper coordinated by the GSC that was submitted for dissemination to staff and representatives of the US Congress, thus influencing several political decisions in Washington, and one of them materializing in tripling the number of US naval exercises, in 2019, in the Black Sea.

Today, the Global Studies Center is the only Romanian civilian actor, a member of the Eastern Partnership think tank network and invited by the Ukrainian Foreign Ministry to join the Crimea Platform.

Another analytical and policy recommendation document, signed by the GSC, dedicated to the situation in Nagorno-Karabakh, was disseminated in March 2021 at the national level and in the reflection groups in Washington, which reacted significantly positively.

I have organized documentary visits for students at the European institutions in Brussels and Strasbourg. As a director of the undergraduate program, I have developed skills for evaluating the quality of study and preaudit programs.

I have developed and adapted specific tools and methodologies that have improved the capacity for analysis and forecasting on particular topics in international relations.

One refers to the development of logical argumentation and public exposition skills in a Karl Popper debate module. The second project is a mentoring program where students meet practitioners and ambassadors who give lectures and present current international events. The third project dedicated to students is a framework for developing analytical skills and policy briefs production. Thus students are linked to valuable networking activities and professional opportunities.
