1.	Dates and Location
	Participants are teaching staff/academics/researchers/young military officers who are willing to take part at the "International Week of "Nicolae Balcescu" Land Forces Academy. The event will be held in the period 13-17 June 2022, during which the participants will also attend lectures, workshops, presentations on international experiences and also visit museums as well as other points of attraction in the city of Sibiu and nearby areas. Participants can also attend the 28th International Scientific Conference – The Knowledge-Based Organization 2022, which will be held in the period 16-17 June 2022, representing a favourable framework within which academics and scientific researchers have the opportunity to share the results obtained in their scientific activity. 2.	Accommodation and meals
	The participants who will choose to stay in the Academy's buildings will be offered accommodation and meals free of charge. We can recommend hotels close to the Academy for those who do not choose to be accommodated inside the Academy and their expenses will be covered by their institutions or by themselves.
3.	Costs
	Accommodation and meals are provided free of charge for all participants who decide to stay inside the Academy. No participation fee is required for the activities held during the International Week. Costs of participation in the International Scientific Conference will be provided upon request to those interested.
4.	Transportation
	Participants are requested to make their own travel arrangements to and from Sibiu (airport/railway station/bus station etc.). "Nicolae Balcescu" Land Forces Academy will provide free transportation from the above mentioned locations to the Academy and back. Transportation from/to local airport or railway stations must be required in advance, preferably one week before arrival to the event. Free transportation for the activities established according to the agenda of the event will be provided for the participants.
